A GUIDE FOR REQUIREMENTS FOR JUDGING GBGVs AFTER 1 JANUARY 2021

Terminology: JEP (BS) – Judges Education Programme (Breed Shows), which superseded the JCF - Judges Competency Framework

TRANSITION PERIOD - JEP (BREED SHOWS) "NEW" SYSTEM

i) IF YOU ARE ALREADY APPROVED TO AWARD CCs IN ANOTHER BREED, you can tick off those mandatory KC seminars already attended/passed. ii) IF YOU ARE NOT APPROVED TO AWARD CCs IN ANY BREED you must attend/pass the various mandatory KC seminars.

TRANSITION PERIOD - "OLD" SYSTEM

- i) IF YOU ARE ALREADY APPROVED TO AWARD CCs IN ANOTHER BREED and are continuing with the "OLD" system for judging GBGVs during the transition period, tick off those KC seminars attended but you must still complete an Update & Transition From to give the Breed Education Co-ordinator and Club Secretary details of your GBGV Breed Specific Seminar/Assessment and Hands-on judging experience.
 - ii) IF YOU ARE NOT APPROVED TO AWARD CCs IN ANY BREED and are continuing with the "OLD" system for judging GBGVs during the transition period, complete an Update & Transition Form to give the BEC and Club Secretary details of ALL KC Seminar/s and Stewarding, as well as ALL Breed Specific Seminars and Hands-on experience.

Decide which route you wish to follow – the Old or the New Route. The following, while not exhaustive, will help you.
